Above Average: 2021 Hurricane Season Briefing

Description

Experts are predicting this hurricane season to be "above average". This 2021 season could see 17 named storms, 8 hurricanes and 4 major hurricanes according to forecasts. In 2020, we saw record breaking numbers with 30 named storms and six major hurricanes. How do we prepare our communities for this upcoming hurricane season and beyond?

Join Florida International University's Extreme Events Institute and our partners at the National Weather Service and Miami-Dade County Emergency Management on what we can expect this season. We will share how best to prepare and highlight our natural hazards research, including FIU's one-of-a-kind Wall of Wind, designated by the National Science Foundation as a National Hazards Engineering Research Infrastructure (NHERI) experimental facility.
